

Election Guidelines in Mobile Ballot Box Voting System

Distribution of Notice of Election:

- House-to-house distribution of notices will commence on May 28, 2024.

Election Duration:

- The mobile balloting box election will be conducted per village on the following schedules from 8 AM until 6 PM.

- Votes will be counted every day based on the schedule per village.

Eligibility to Vote:

- Only LEHOA members in good standing or their validated proxies are allowed to vote.
- Each LEHOA member in good standing is entitled to one (1) vote per unit owned.

Voting Process:

Receiving the Ballot:

- After initial verification, LEHOA member will be handed a ballot form.

Casting the Vote:

- Fill out the ballot form as per the instructions provided and affix your signatures in the counterfoil.
- Homeowners or validated proxies should fold and deposit their ballots and counterfoil into the sealed transparent ballot box.
- Ensure that your vote is clearly marked and legible to avoid any misinterpretation or invalidation.

Vote Counting Process:

Polling Place:

- The designated secured location where the counting of votes will be conducted is in St. Edward School Faith Campus, General Trias, Cavite. The Election Committee and designated officials will conduct the vote count.

Secure Transport:

- Mobile balloting boxes will be securely transported to the designated polling place at the end of every day during the voting period.

Verification of Ballot Forms:

- Ballot forms will be verified for authenticity and eligibility by the Election Committee before counting begins.
- Any irregular or disputed ballot forms will be set aside for further review.
- Invalid ballot forms will not be counted.

Counting Procedure:

- The election officials will verify if all of the ballot boxes are properly sealed and intact before opening.
- Ballot boxes will be opened one at a time in a pre-determined sequence.

- Each ballot forms will be counted manually under the supervision of the Election Committee.
- Votes will be recorded on a tally sheet and board simultaneously.
- Election Committee will periodically check and verify tallies to ensure accuracy.
- Once counting is complete, there will be reconciliation on the tally sheet and board with the initial ballot forms count.

Security and Integrity:

- The vote counting area will be secured and the proceedings will be recorded to ensure the integrity of the count.
- Only Election Committee members will be allowed to open the ballot boxes.
- Only Phase Representatives will be allowed to select poll watchers.
- Selected poll watchers must be a member in good standing.
- A maximum of 3 poll watchers will be allowed each counting day to observe counting proceedings.

Announcement of Election Result:

- Final results will be verified and certified by the Election Committee before the official announcement.
- Official announcement will be posted in the official LEHOA portal and website.

Important Reminders:

- Follow the instructions on the ballot paper carefully to ensure your vote is valid.
- Respect the voting hours (8:00 AM to 6:00 PM) to ensure your vote is counted.
- One vote per household unit is strictly enforced to maintain the election's integrity.
